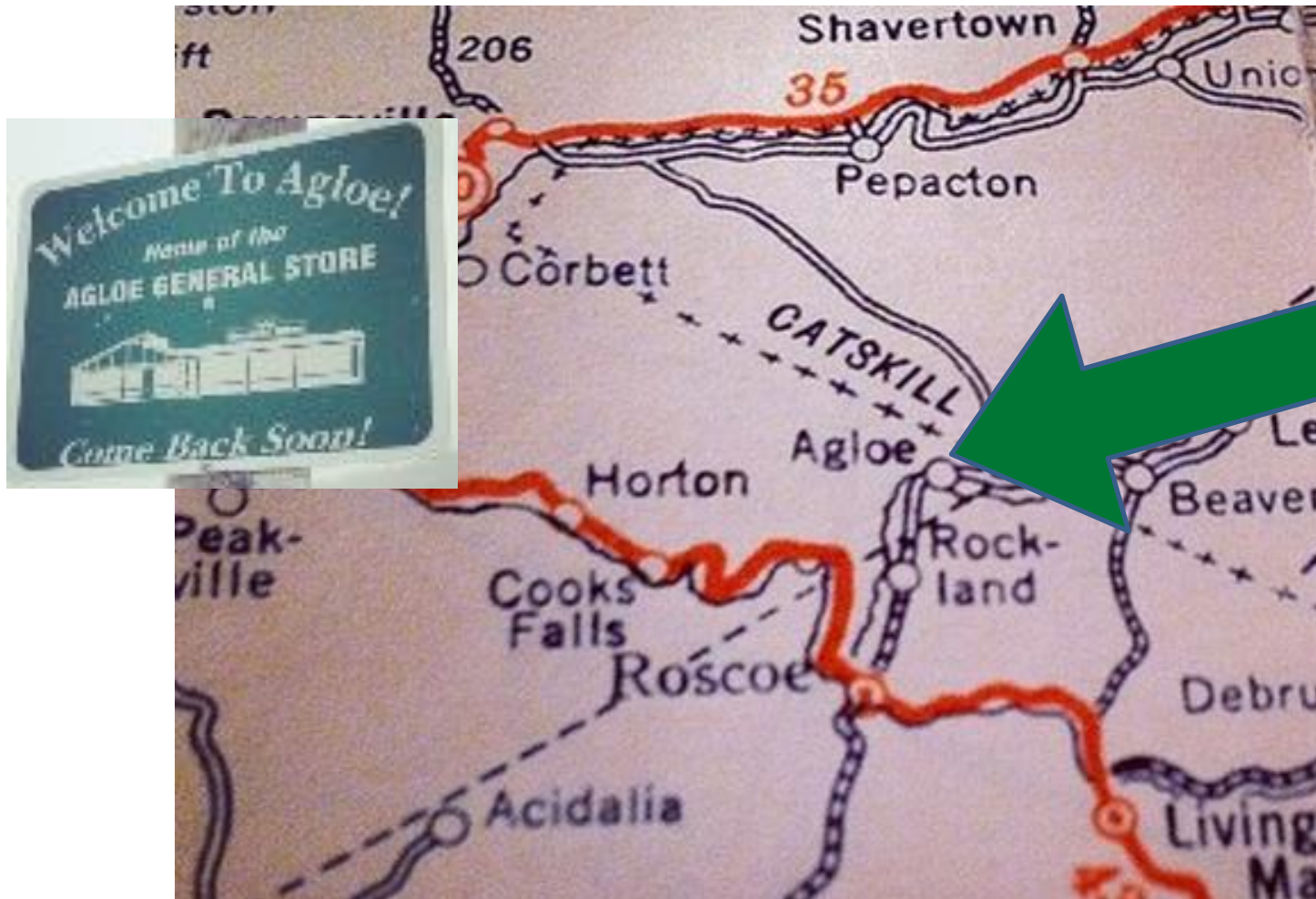


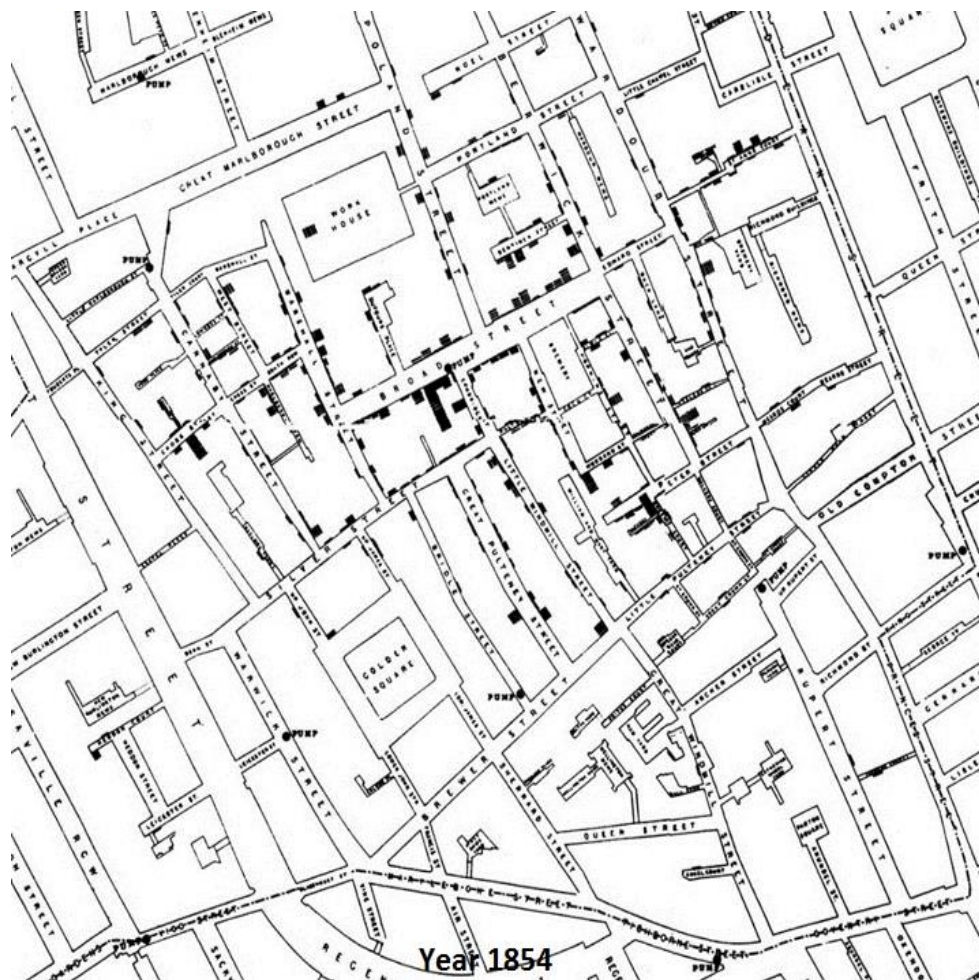

Maps create reality: Agloe town



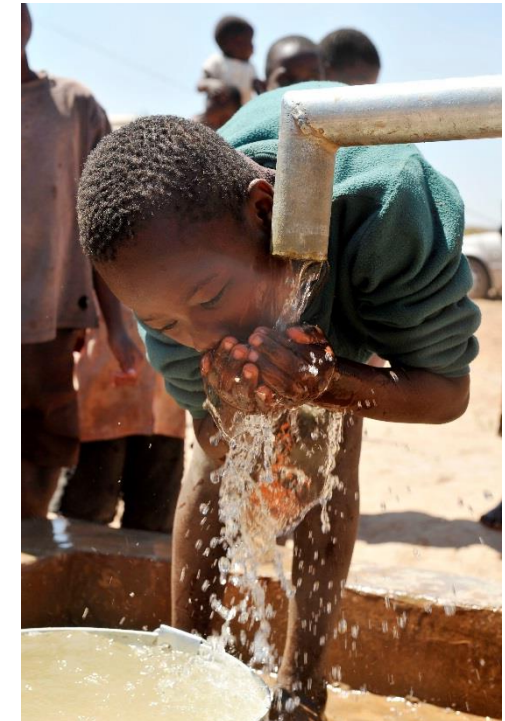
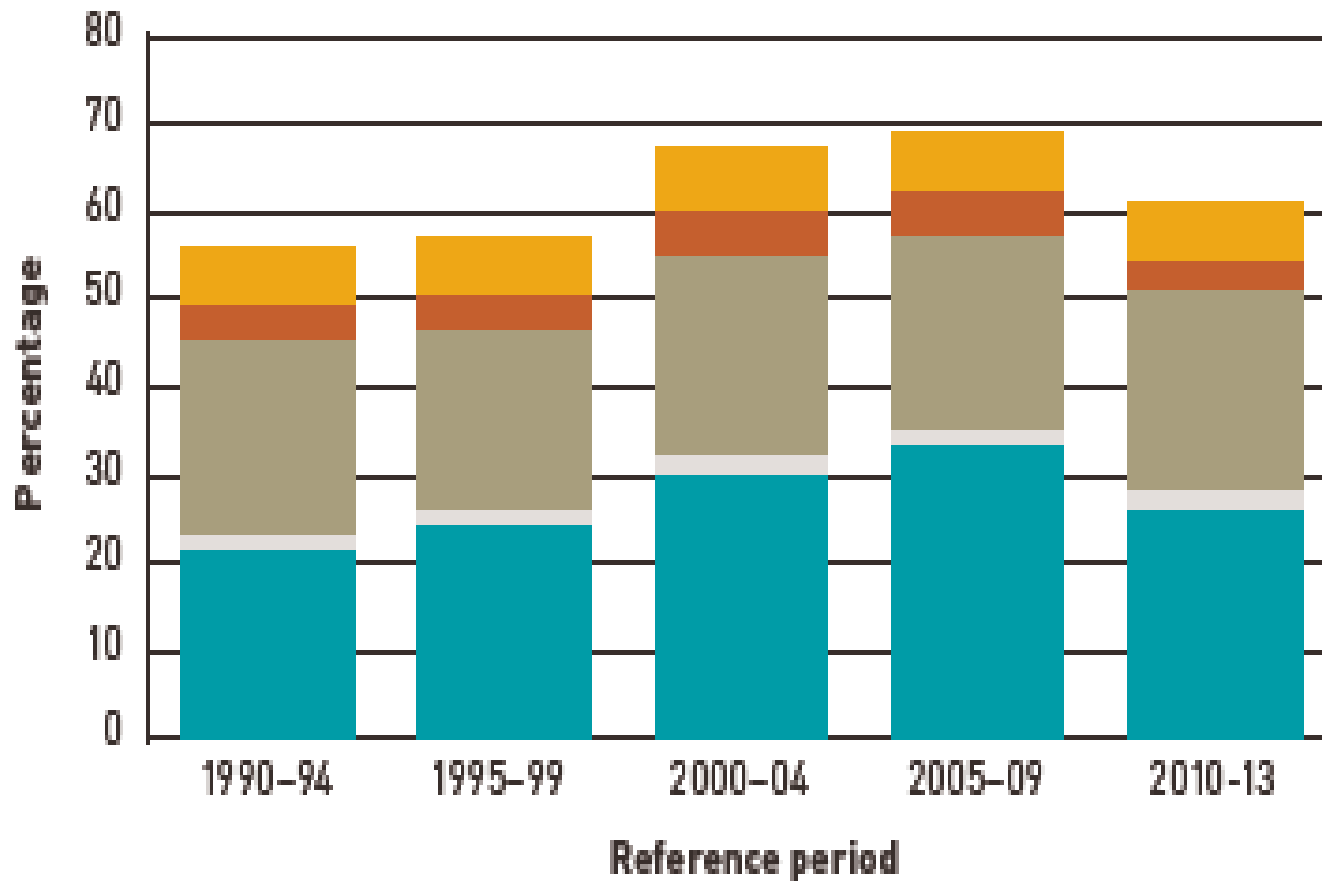
Link Goal 17. Strengthen the means of implementation and revitalize the global partnership for sustainable development

- Support decision making with data, information and knowledge – not just trends, but also evidence and solutions.
- Encourage geospatial data use to address and manage sustainable development challenges and then use the data to improve monitoring.
