- EUR 404 Billion in budget period 2014-2020
- Multiple EU funds with specific foci
- Targeting mostly “less developed” EU regions with >70% of budget

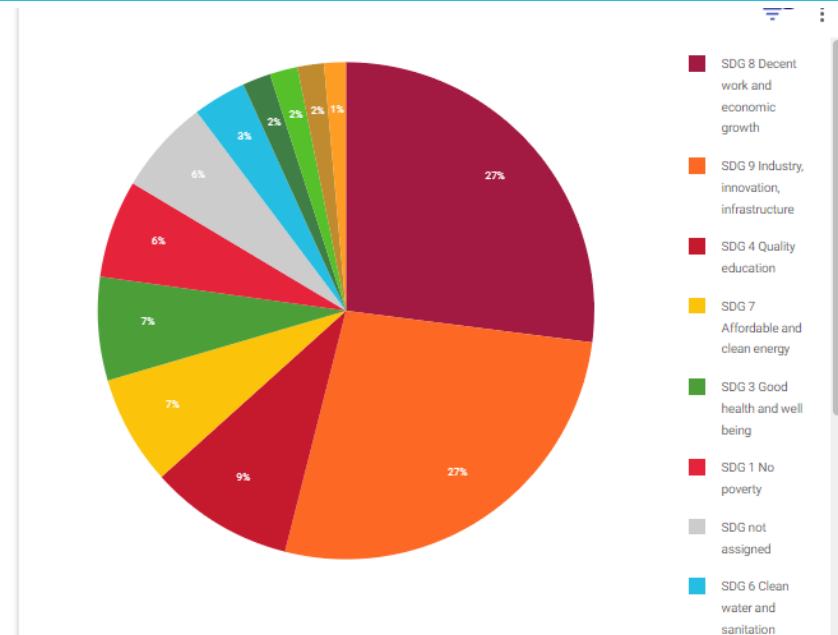
The interactive pie chart on the right shows the volume of Cohesion policy funding contributing to the 11 relevant SDGs.

The majority of EU Cohesion policy funding - 94% - contributes to the 11 UN SDGs identified.

The majority of this funding is allocated to 2 SDGs - SDG 9 Industry, innovation, infrastructure and SDG 8 Decent work and economic growth.

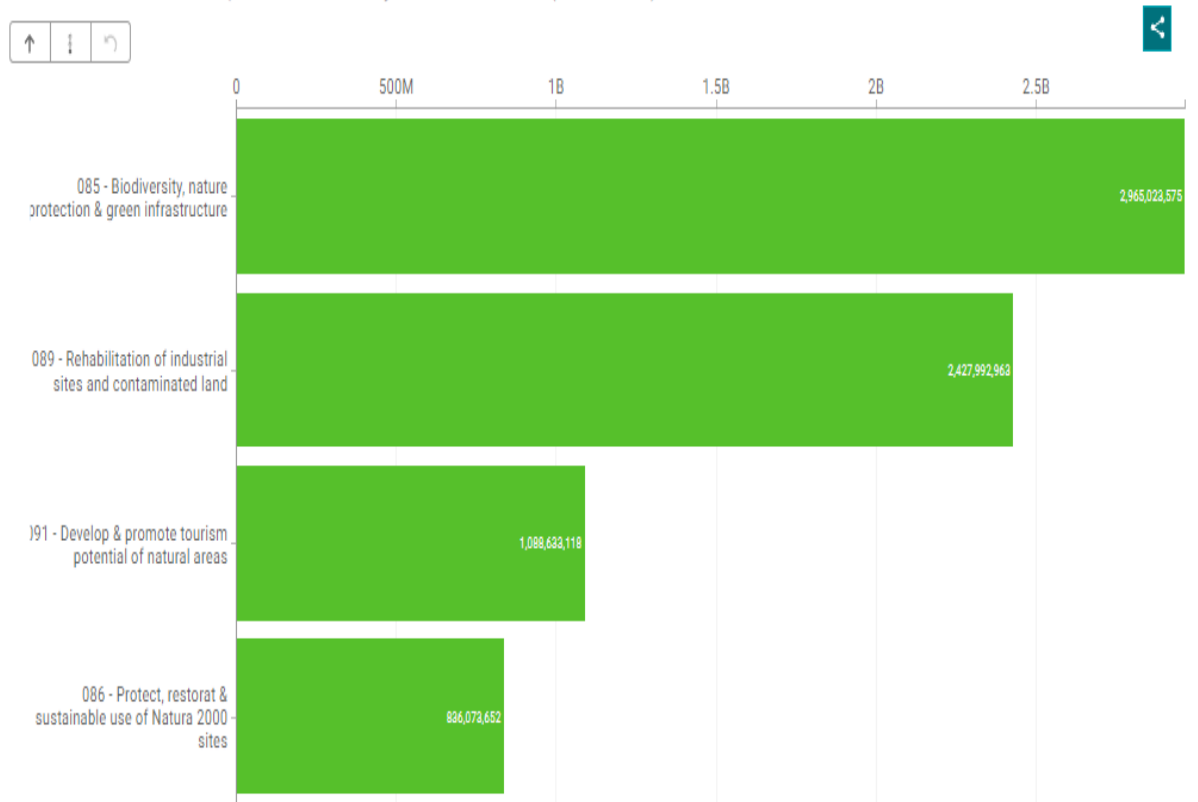

SDG 15 Life on Land: EU planned amount by intervention field (2014-2020)



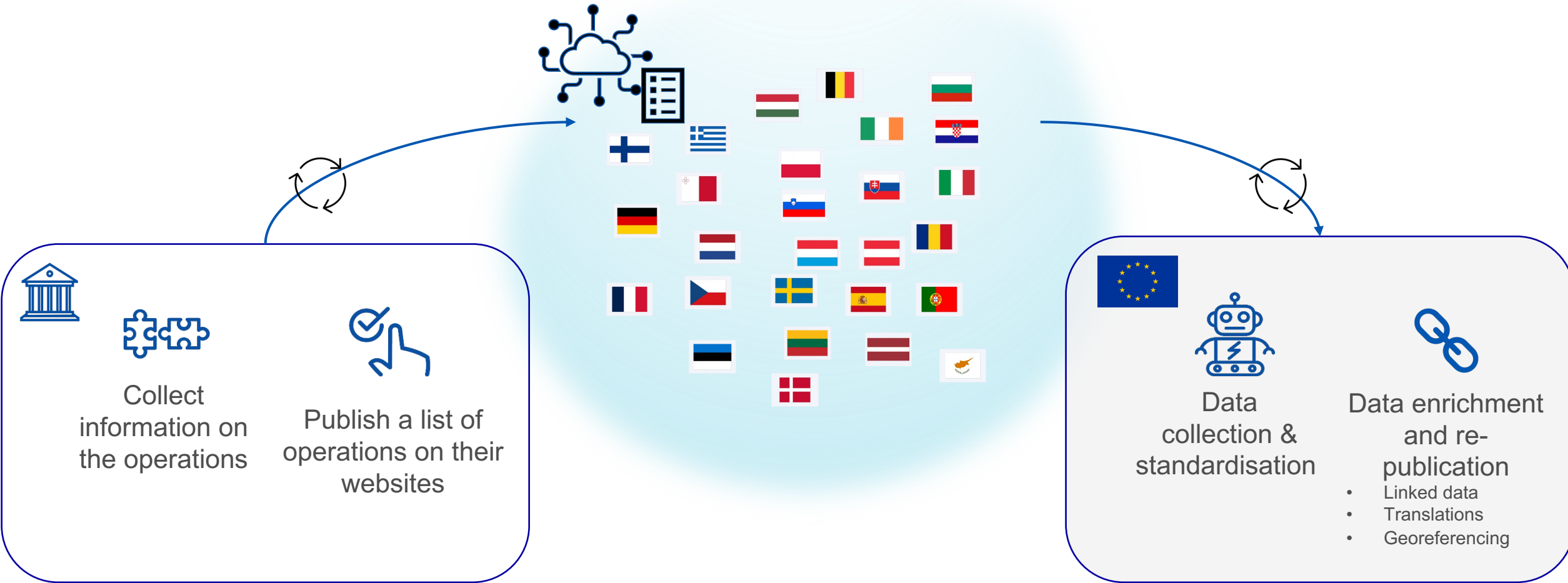
